COURSE OUTLINE

- Chimneys and drafts..
- Combustion equipment and efficiency testing.
- Highlighting the Beckett flame retention burners and accessories.
- Service procedures during the seasonal maintenance, how to inspect and repair oil burners - homeowner basics, service technician basics, diagnosis, repair.
- Understanding, troubleshooting and correction of system problems: combustion, chimney, ignition system, safety control system, fuel unit and oil piping, motors, fans and couplings.
