COURSE OVERVIEW

As sewer system networks age, the risk of deterioration, blockages, and collapses becomes a major concern. As a result, communities worldwide are taking proactive measures to improve performance levels of their sewer systems. Cleaning and inspecting sewer lines are essential to maintaining a properly functioning system; these activities further a community's reinvestment into its wastewater infrastructure.

COURSE OUTLINE

- Why operation and maintenance? (the wastewater collection system operator, why O & M?)
- WC Systems - Purpose, components, design (purpose, components, design).
- Inspecting and testing collection systems (inspecting collection systems, inspection of manholes, CCTV, smoke testing, dye testing).
- Cleaning and maintenance methods (identifying problems and selecting solutions, hydraulic cleaning, mechanical cleaning, equipment maintenance, chemicals).
- Underground repair (underground work, shoring, construction, repair of service lines, main lines, sealing grout, manhole repairs).
- Safety procedures (routing traffic, manhole hazards, equipment and procedures for confined space entry, safety equipment and procedures, excavations, other concerns).
- Appendices.
