COURSE OVERVIEW

Safety in the Workplace is an online course for water plant operators. The objectives of the course are:

- to list the responsibilities of operators and management for waterworks safely,
- to identify and safely handle hazardous chemicals,
- to recognize fire hazards and properly extinguish various types of fires,
- to safely maintain waterworks equipment and facilities,
- to properly operate and maintain vehicles,
- to recognize electrical hazards,
- to safely perform duties in a laboratory, and
- to protect operators and yourself while working in and around waterworks facilities.

- Chemical handling (acids, bases, gases, salts, powders, WHMIS).
- Fire protection (classifications, fire extinguishers).
